

# Assessment & Evaluation

## 1. Classes Nursery to V (Primary Section)

### Assessment Structure:

- *Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE)*: Focus on holistic development, including cognitive, psychomotor, and affective domains.
- *Formative Assessments (FA)*: Regular observations, oral tests, activities, and worksheets.
- *Summative Assessments (SA)*: End of term exams (twice a year).

## 2. Classes VI to VIII (Middle Section)

### Assessment Structure:

- *Two Terms*: Term 1 (April to September) and Term 2 (October to March).
- *Formative Assessments (FA)*: Class work, homework, projects, quizzes.
- *Summative Assessments (SA)*: Written exams at the end of each term.

### Evaluation Criteria:

- Languages (English, Hindi/Punjabi)

- Mathematics
- Science
- Social Science
- *Co-Scholastic Areas:*
- Art Education
- Work Education
- Health and Physical Education
- *Grading Scale:* 9-point grading scale from A1 (highest) to E (needs improvement).

### ***3. Classes IX and X (Secondary Section)***

#### **Assessment Structure:**

- *Annual Examination:* Board exams for Class X, with periodic tests and internal assessments for Class IX.
- *Internal Assessments:* 20 marks in each subject, divided into:
- Periodic Tests: 5 marks
- Notebook Submission: 5 marks
- Subject Enrichment Activities: 5 marks
- Multiple Assessments: 5 marks

#### **Evaluation Criteria:**

##### *Scholastic Areas:*

- Languages (English, Hindi/Sanskrit/other regional language)
- Mathematics (Standard/Basic)
- Science
- Social Science
- *Co-Scholastic Areas:*
- Art Education
- Health and Physical Education
- Work Experience
- General Studies
- *Grading Scale:* 8-point grading scale from A1 (91-100 marks) to E (below 33 marks).

### ***4. Classes XI and XII (Senior Secondary Section)***

#### **Assessment Structure:**

- *Annual Examination:* Board exams for Class XII, with internal assessments and unit tests for Class XI.
- *Periodic Tests:* Term-wise unit tests, half-yearly exams, pre-board exams.
- *Practical Examinations:* For subjects like Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Accountancy, etc.

#### **Stream-wise Evaluation Criteria:**

##### *Science Stream:*

- Core Subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics, English.
- Optional Subjects: Physical Education
- Internal assessments and practical exams as per CBSE guidelines.
- *Commerce Stream:*
- Core Subjects: Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Mathematics, English.
- Optional Subjects: Physical Education,
- Project work and practical for Accountancy, Business Studies, and Economics.
- *Humanities Stream:*
- Core Subjects: History, Political Science, English.
- Optional Subjects: Economics, Mathematics, Physical Education, etc.
- Project work in subjects like History, Political Science, etc.
- *Grading Scale:* 9-point grading scale similar to classes IX and X.

## ***General CBSE Guidelines:***

- *Promotion Policy:* Based on cumulative performance in both formative and summative assessments.
- *Attendance:* Minimum of 75% attendance is required to be eligible for final exams.
- *Student Portfolios:* Compilation of academic and co-curricular achievements.
- *Remedial Classes:* For students needing additional help.
